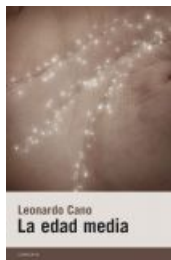

In 'The Middle Ages' three stories take place overlapping in time, shot through with the anxiety, humour and tragedy of thwarted hopes.
